



On April 14, 1989, Ramon Salcido murdered his wife, her two younger sisters, his mother-in-law, the man he suspected his wife was having an affair with, and he slashed the throats of his three young daughters - 4 year old Sophia, 3 year old Carmina, and 22 month old Theresa.

A day later, investigators found the bodies of these young girls in the county dump. One of the girls survived - 3 year old Carmina.
