Judge Bertoli truly cares about the family law litigants that come into his courtroom. **Jody Rogers** will share her own journey of addiction, losing her children and getting them back! She's been a Parent Mentor at CPI for the past two years where she helps other families navigate their journey to reunification of their family.

Her primary responsibility is the oversight for all parenting programs. In addition, she provides leadership support to the children's counselling clinic integrate and support those programs.

**Rachelle Lynch**, is the supervisor of the Family and Community Engagement (FACE) Unit at Family, Youth and Children's Division (formerly CPS). FACE consists of: Child Family Team Meetings; Mandated Reporter Community Outreach; and the Relative Coordinator position. As a social worker, she worked in Family Reunification, Voluntary Family Maintenance, and was the Linkages Social Worker (liaison between SonomaWORKS and CPS).
