Scott Montgomery is a lawyer who handles civil cases for child sexual abuse survivors seeking monetary compensation for the harms they will suffer during their lives. In 2023 and 2024 Scott obtained two significant jury verdicts for child sexual abuse survivors compensating them for their harms, one in the amount of \$24 million, and another in the amount \$46 million.



Ashley Hendon is a Deputy District Attorney at the Sonoma County District Attorney's Office. She has been a prosecutor for 13 years. She currently works in the Sexual Assault Unit as well as the Human Trafficking Unit, where she focuses on prosecution of sex offenses against children and adults, as well as all human trafficking crimes.



Lisa Diaz-McQuaid is a survivor leader in the anti-trafficking movement, co-founder of Redemption House of the Bay Area, and Lead Human Trafficking Caseworker at Verity. She is a passionate advocate for Missing and Murdered Indigenous Women (MMIW) and the founder of VOICE (Voices of Ceremonial Exploitation), a support group for indigenous survivors. Lisa is also a mentor, author, and community educator, dedicated to raising awareness about the Commercial Sexual Exploitation of Children (CSEC) and human trafficking.
