



## **Sonoma County Women in Law Community Advocacy Scholarship**

With the support of a grant from the Sonoma County Board of Supervisors, Sonoma County Women in Law (“SCWiL”) is pleased to offer one Community Advocacy Scholarship (the “Scholarship”) in an amount of at least \$2,000. The purpose of the Scholarship is to support a deserving law student who has demonstrated a strong commitment to serving the Sonoma County community by helping offset the cost of their legal education. This Scholarship is open to all applicants regardless of gender.

### **Eligibility**

To be eligible for the Scholarship, applicants must:

1. Have completed at least one year of law school by May 2026, and have at least one year remaining before completing their Juris Doctor degree;
2. Demonstrate established ties to Sonoma County;
3. Show meaningful involvement in Sonoma County community affairs; and
4. Exhibit academic excellence.

### **Application Requirements**

To apply for the Scholarship, applicants must submit the following materials:

1. An essay of no more than two pages describing their ties to Sonoma County and their involvement in Sonoma County community affairs; and
2. A copy of their most recent law school transcript.
